Status of Consent to Establish from KSPCB: We have obtained consent to establish vide no.PCB/HO/EE2/EKM/ICE/18/2016 dated 12.07.16 for Laying of LPG pipeline from Puthuvypeen import terminal to Kochi Refinery in Kerala and validity of the same was renewed up to 31.12.2023 vide no. R16ERRCTE287481 dated 11.12.2018. Consent to Operate for Kochi Refinery to Puthuvypeen was obtained vide no. KSPCB/ER1/ICO/10030330/2023 and is valid up to 31.12.2028

KSPPL Project status: KSPPL has commissioned the section of pipeline between Kochi to Palakkad of about 203 KM in the state of Kerala i.e. 39Km of Puthuvypin to Kochi Refinery and 153 km of Kochi refinery to Palakkad has been successfully commissioned in August and October 2023 respectively. The pipeline 12km, between Kochi refinery and Udayamperoor stands commissioned since August 2017. All the pipeline sections were commissioned with due compliance to the audit recommendations of OISD and PESO. The pipeline is fully into commercial Operation since then. The pipeline has also obtained all statutory approvals and sanctions from the respective authorities such as PNGRB, PESO, Environmental Clearance from Kerala State PCB.
